

CHS ABSOLUTES

1. NO CELL PHONES, MUSIC PLAYERS OR HEADPHONES

May not be visible or audible at any time in the building.

A teacher may allow use in a classroom for one class, but use must stop in hallway or when a substitute teacher is in the room.

Response

1st offense: Confiscate, return at end of the day, referral, point deduction.

2nd offense: Confiscate, parent must come in to pick up, referral, point deduction.

3rd offense: School keeps device until parent teacher conference night - parent must come to the meeting in order to get the phone back, referral, point deduction.

Refusal to give up device

1st offense: 1 day suspension, point deduction.

2nd offense: 3 day suspension, point deduction.

3rd offense: CO conference (5 day suspension).

2. HOMEWORK

1st- 3rd offenses of quarter: Complete the homework violation form (point deduction) as a family to indicate the steps that will be taken to assure that homework is completed in the future.

4th offense of quarter: Request an in-school conference with teacher and parent/guardian, document, point deduction.

5th offense of quarter: Student will be placed in *Extended Day* after school Tuesday and Thursday and may stay in the building on Community Service Wednesdays for the remainder of the quarter. The child must complete his/her homework before leaving the *Extended Day* session each day.

3. LATE BETWEEN CLASSES

1st offense: Documented warning, point deduction.

2nd - 4th offense: Detention, documented, point deduction.

5th offense: Behavior contract, point deduction, placed on "No Hallway List".

6th offense: In-house suspension, parent conference, point deduction.

4. LEAVING and/or COMING BACK TO THE BUILDING w/o permission

- All personal appointments must be made outside of school. Students will not be allowed to use the phone to make appointments or find out information about appointments (including bringing lunch).
- Parents/guardians must call the office to speak with their child.
- Leaving the building without permission will be handled as truancy. If a student leaves **with or without permission**, he/she will not be allowed to return without a parent/guardian note.

5. DRESS CODE

Students will not be allowed in class until their dress is appropriate. Failure to dress appropriately will result in parent contact, documentation, and point deduction.

6. LIMITED HALLWAY DURING CLASS

Students may obtain **2 hall passes each quarter** with each teacher. Additional passes will require a detention to be served, documentation, and point deduction.

7. VERBAL ABUSE

Verbal abuse of any kind (**HARASSMENT / BULLYING / PROFANITY / ARGUING WITH STAFF OR STUDENTS**) will not be tolerated, and will result in documented interventions, parent conferences, and/or suspensions.

8. FOOD LIMITED TO CAFETERIA and breakfast in the classroom

Students can only eat food outside of the cafeteria from 8:45-9:15, and **can only occur inside the homeroom**.

At no time should students be eating in the hallway, bathroom, gym, locker room, etc.

9. NO INTERRUPTIONS - NO SIDE CONVERSATIONS OR OFF TASK BEHAVIOR IN THE CLASSROOM

All students have a right to a productive and intellectually safe school environment. Consequences include removal from class, point deduction, parent contact, and/or suspension from school.

10. BRING NECESSARY MATERIALS TO CLASS

Students are only allowed to leave classroom 2 times per quarter. Any time after 2 will be a detention.
